

THE CITY OF NAIN
God's Only Son Raises The Widow's Only Son
Luke 7:11-17



Off in the distance you can see what is suspected to be the remains of the city of Nain from the time of Christ. Resting at the foot of the mountain hill, there would be a short ascent into the city.



The above image shows a closer view of the city with the road that leads into its main entrance. This could have been a similar path that Jesus and His followers had traveled on when approaching Nain.



Notice the various representations of the first resurrection miracle of Christ in His ministry. Some details to pay attention to are the types of biers that would be used to carry the dead, the type of burial cloth wrappings that would be used, and the expressions displayed by all who are present at the time of the miracle.
